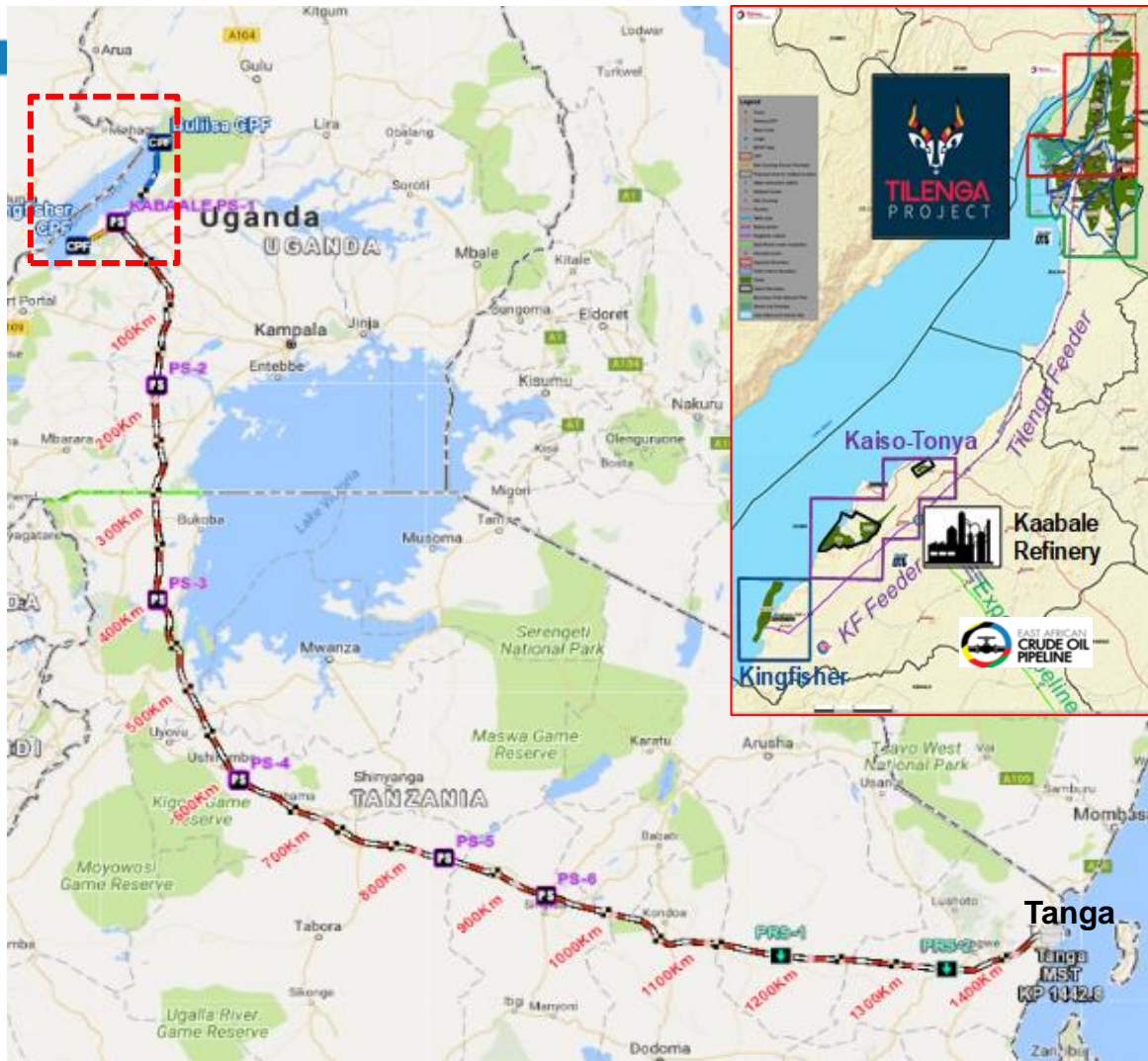

EACOP – PART OF LAKE ALBERT DEVELOPMENT

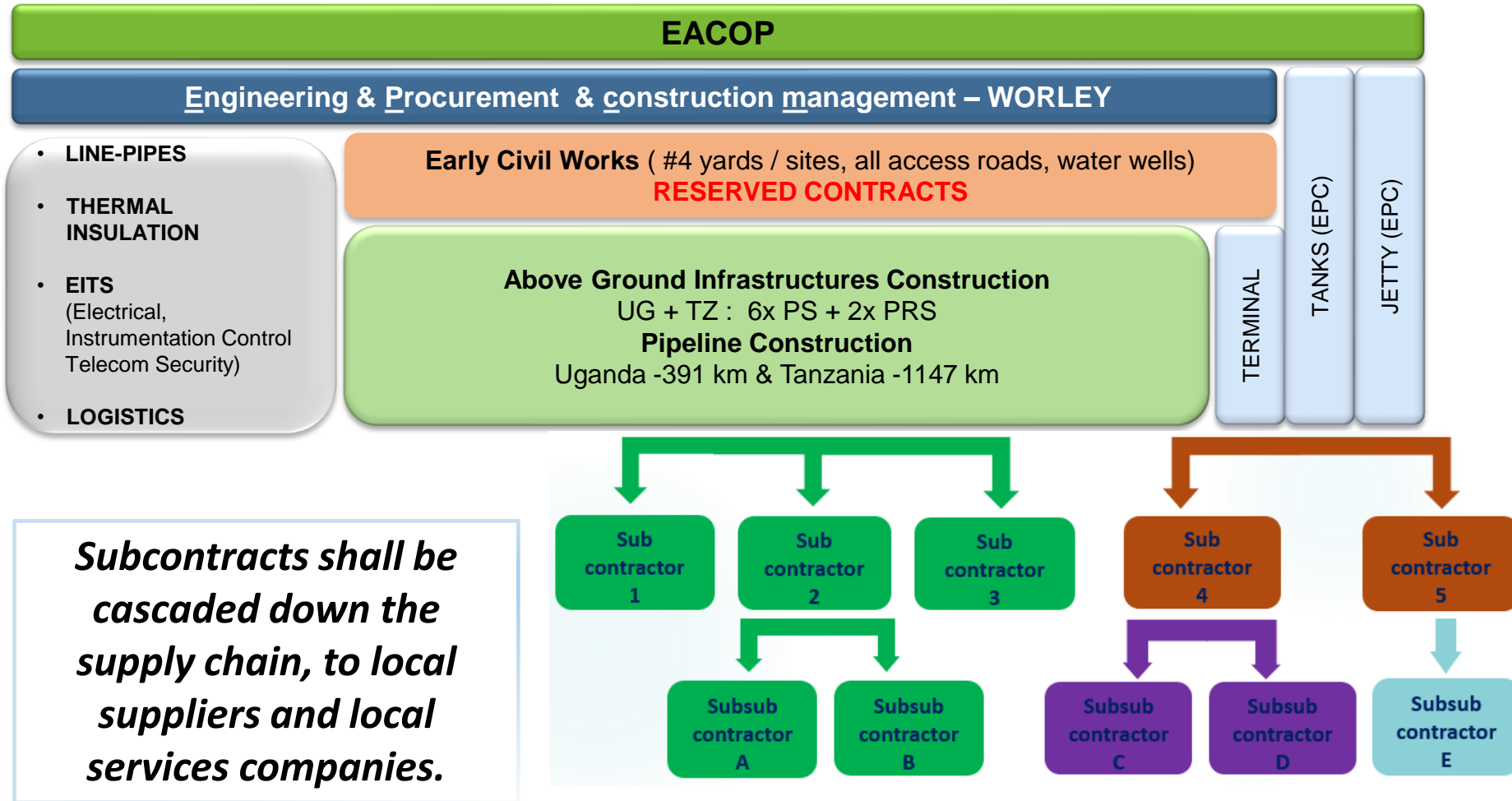

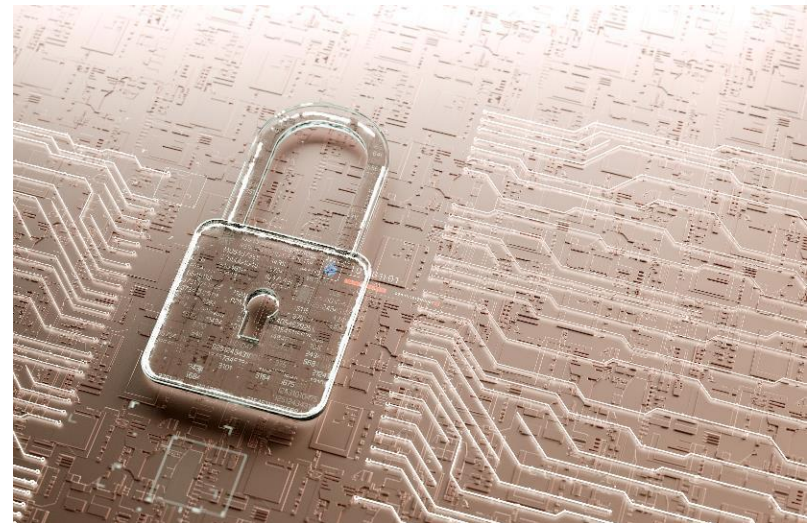

TOTAL East Africa Midstream B.V. (Company), an Oil & Gas company, invites experienced and reputable contractors to express their interest in construction of replacement houses under the East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP), Project Resettlement Action Plan (RAP) implementation.

The EACOP project involves the construction and operation of a buried cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from the Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale in Hoima District, Uganda, to the Kileleshwa Region, in Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 1,300 km will be in Tanzania. The section of the pipeline in Tanzania will traverse eight (8) regions, 27 administrative district councils and 231 Villages.

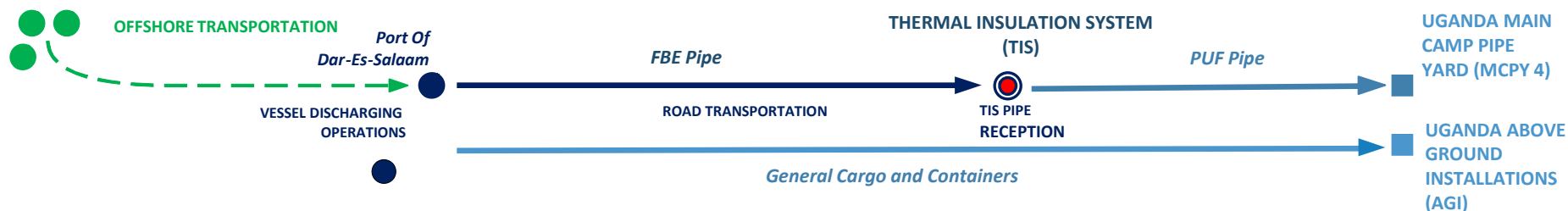

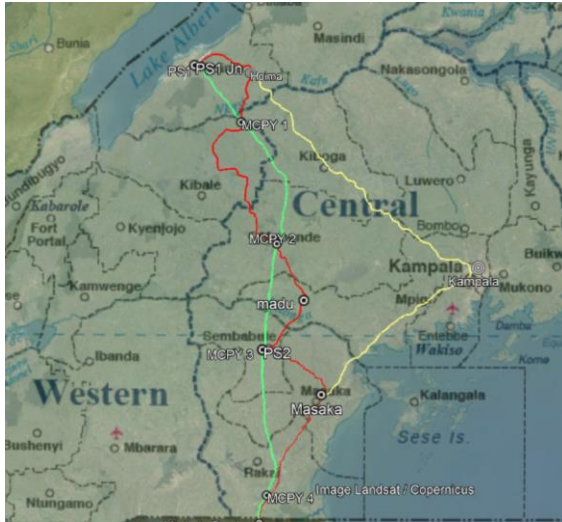

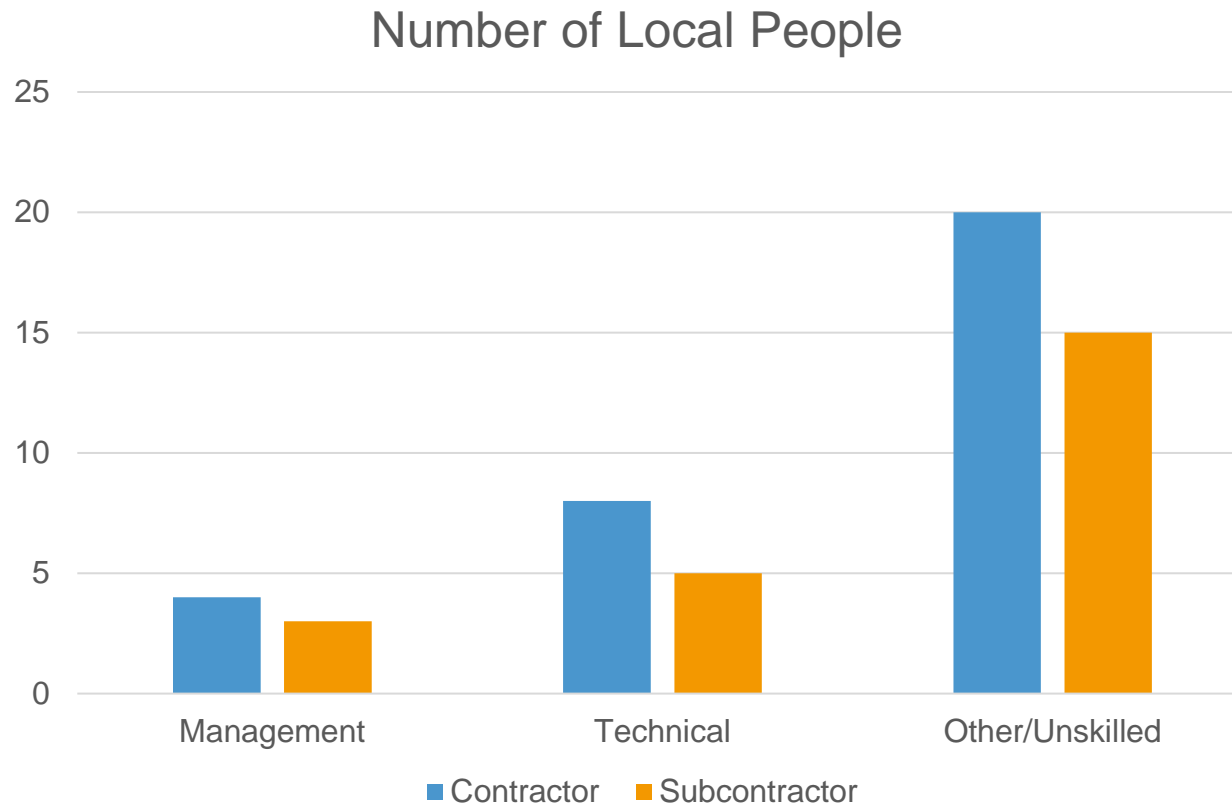
