- 1 in Uganda connected to the UTILITY via a 132kV transmission line at PS1
- 3 in Tanzania via Crude Oil/Diesel power generation plants at PS3 (PS4???), PS5 and MST

Section are composed of Pumping Station, Reduction Station and also pipeline station:

- Long Line Heat Tracing station (LLHT, also named EHT): Crude oil has high viscosity and needs to be above 50°C for pumping
- Main Line Blok Valve station (MLBV)

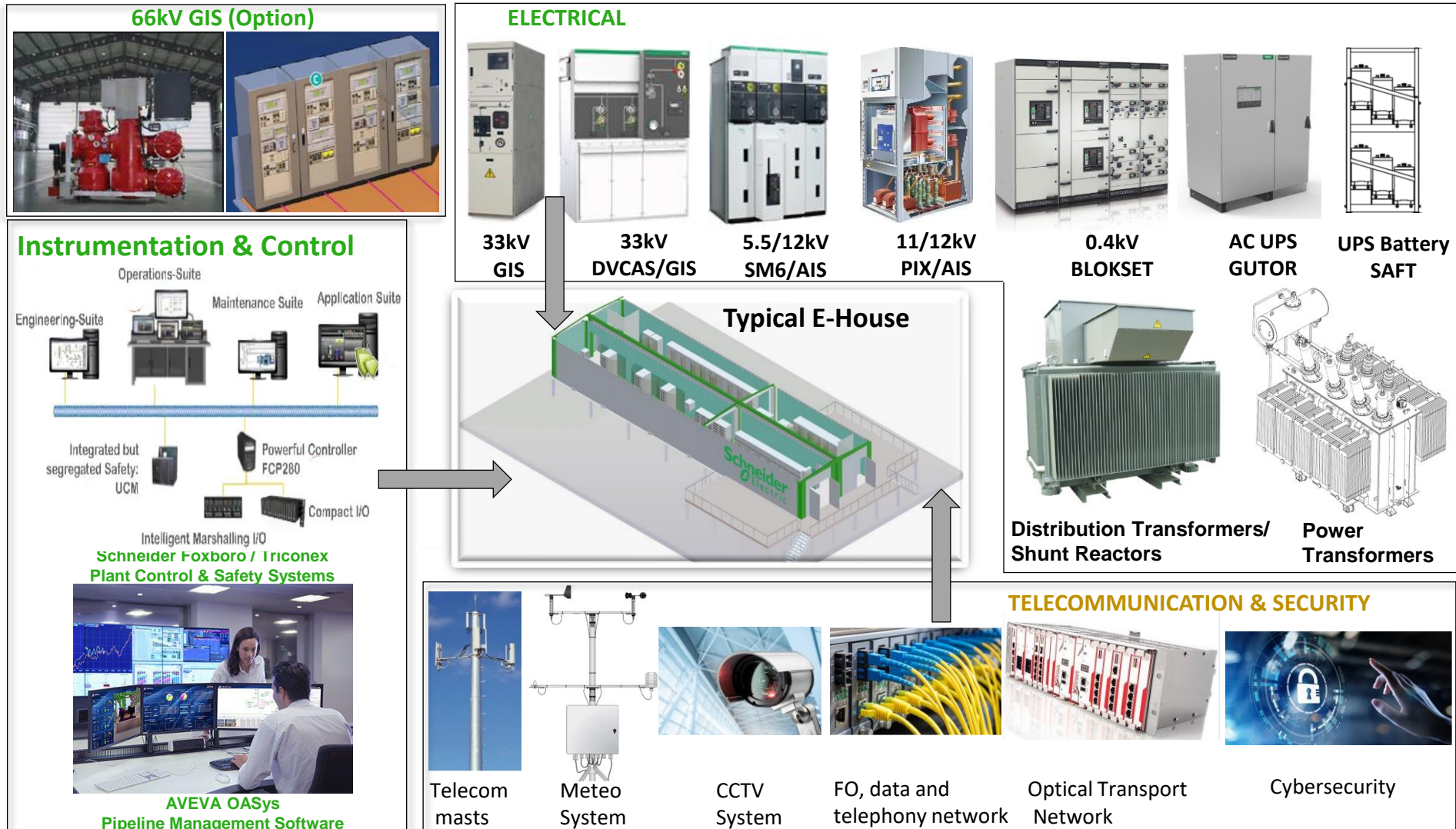

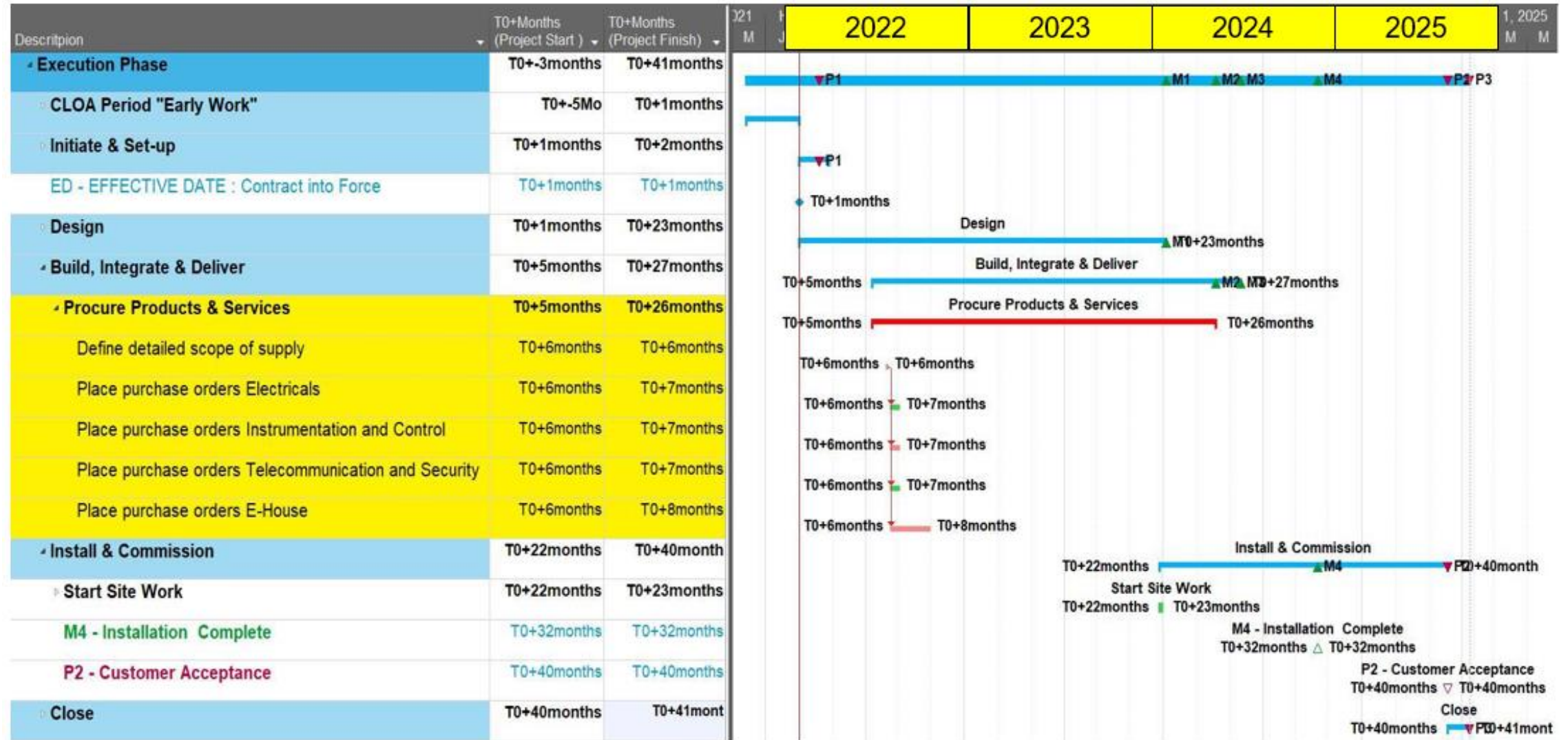

- Registration to NSD is mandatory (pre-requisite) for any local companies to participate to any CFT
- EOIs will be published in local news-papers and open & public link (e.g. <https://eacop.com/opportunities-by-main-construction-contractors/schneider-uganda-ltd/>) to any potential suppliers
- Local companies that will respond to an EOI will have :
  - To comply with some qualification requirements (eg: Based on package complexity, various ISO certificates may be required (ISO9001, ISO14001, ISO45001))
  - Answer to EOI and submit their bid within the specified time limits and with all supporting documentation
- Following RFI and creation of short list, on site audits may be performed by EITS Contractor to finally qualify suppliers



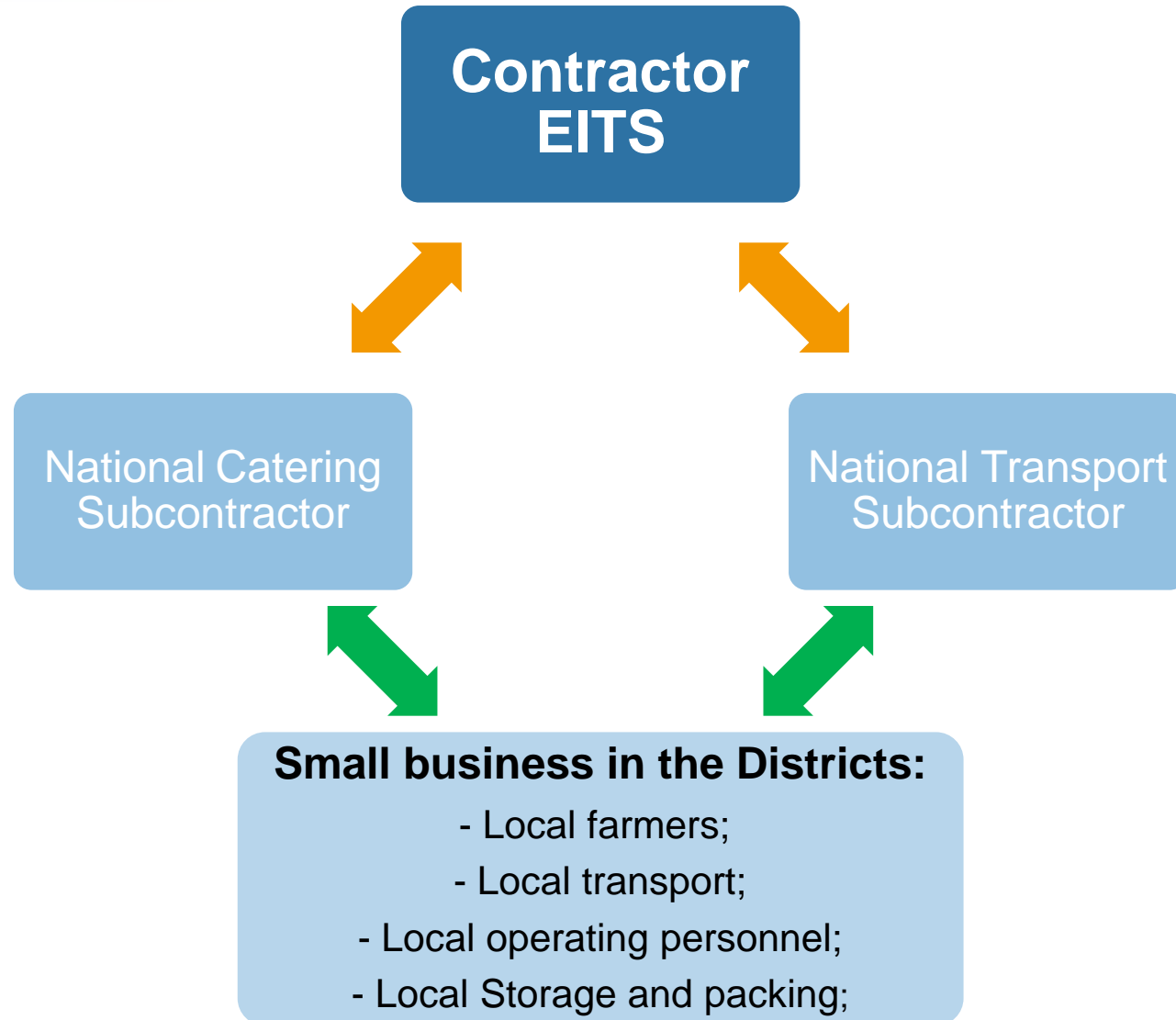
